


Cart Placement Guidelines

Advanced Disposal Automated Cart Collection program is designed to make it easier for residents to handle their waste & recycling services. With automated collection programs, there are a few cart placement guidelines to follow. Your help is appreciated in making it easier for carts to be collected:

- Your cart should be within 18 inches of the curb with the arrow on the lid pointing to the street/curb. Carts can be placed on the street or the terrace (as long as they are within 18 inches of the curb).
- To avoid damage to property, place the cart at least three feet from mailboxes, lamp posts, and other fixed objects.
- Place your cart on as level of a surface as possible, but away from low-hanging tree branches.
- Place recycling carts at least three feet away from garbage carts.
- Close lids prior to pick-up—lids should be closed on carts in order to stop material from spilling or blowing away prior to collection.

Commonly Asked Questions

WHO WILL BE PROVIDING SERVICE? The City has signed a contract with Advanced Disposal to provide residential curbside trash and recycling services.

WHEN WILL THE SERVICE BEGIN? Advanced Disposal will be delivering new carts the week of August 6th. The first scheduled trash pick-up with Advanced Disposal will be the week of August 13th and the first recycling pick-up will be the week of August 20th.

WHAT WILL I BE CHARGED EVERY MONTH? The charge for the weekly trash pick-up and every other week recycling pick-up will be \$12.91 per month. Each year there is a maximum adjustment rate of 2 1/2%. The monthly fee will be placed on your Utility Bill starting in September of 2012.

WHAT DO I DO ABOUT MY CURRENT SERVICE? Contact your trash provider and cancel your residential services effective August 10th make sure you tell them your address, and that you are residents of the City of Waupun who now has a municipal contract for garbage collection with Advanced Disposal.

WHAT DO I DO WITH MY CURRENT RECYCLE BIN? If your bin is in good shape and you would like to keep it for other uses than recycling, you can; otherwise on your first week of pick-up, place your old recycle bin in your new recycling container and it will be recycled.

WHO PROVIDES RECYCLING/TRASH RECEPTACLES? Advanced Disposal will provide one 95 gallon yellow covered wheeled cart for recycling and one 95 gallon wheeled cart for garbage to every customer that currently pays for recycling services on your Utility bill. If you are a current customer of Veolia and you have a 95 gallon trash cart, they will be looking at those to see if they need to be replaced. If your container is in good shape, Advanced Disposal will not be replacing it.

Commonly Asked Questions (Cont.)

IF I MOVE TO A NEW HOME WHAT DO I DO WITH THE RECEPTACLES AT MY HOUSE? All containers are owned by and property of Advanced Disposal. The receptacles must remain with the property.

WHEN WILL MY TRASH/RECYCLING BE PICKED UP? Please see the map on the reverse side with the routes. Advanced Disposal will also be providing each property with a schedule. Information is also available on our website at www.cityofwaupun.org

Other Info

All trash/recycling produced from a residence must be placed in the appropriate receptacle. During the transition, the following will occur if this is not complied with.

Week 1—Advanced Disposal will collect all garbage bags placed outside of containers.

Week 2—Advanced Disposal will collect all garbage bags placed outside of containers, but place a tag on your bin.

Week 3—Advanced Disposal will tag your container and not pick-up anything not in the container.

Electronics Recycling

Bargains Galore Thrift Store offers free electronics recycling. Items that can be recycled include TV's, CPU's, Laptops, Copiers, Phones, Mice, Keyboards, Computer Monitors, Printers/Scanners, Fax Machines, VCR/DVD players, Cell phones/PDA's, Stereo Equipment, Cables/Cords, Game Systems, Any & All Computer Accessories.

Bulk Pick-up

Part of the contract with Advanced Disposal is to provide residents with two bulk pick-up dates per year. They will be held the 2nd week of April and the 2nd week of October each year. Bulk items will be picked up on your normal trash pick-up date. Items may not be placed at the curb prior than 24 hours to your scheduled pick-up date. Below are guidelines for pick-up. (Please check the City Calendar at www.cityofwaupun.org for exact dates)

The following items are identified as bulk waste that will be collected:

- Furniture
- Rolled carpeting (4ft maximum length)
- Cabinets
- Countertops
- Mattresses/bed springs
- Non-metal doors
- Wood windows
- Wooden playground equipment

Excluded items:

- Uncontainerized or piles of construction material
- Large appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, etc)
- Freon-containing items (refrigerators, AC units, freezers)
- Tires
- Batteries
- Fluorescent lights/bulbs
- TVs/DVD players/VCR
- Computer equipment
- Electronic Items banned from landfills

Drop Off Center Closing

The Drop Off Center closed on November 1, 2012 due to this service. An area will be provided for City residents to drop off yard waste (tree branches, leaves, garden materials, etc.), oil and anti-freeze. This area will be open 24 hours a day 7 days a week and will be located at the same location as the drop off center.
