

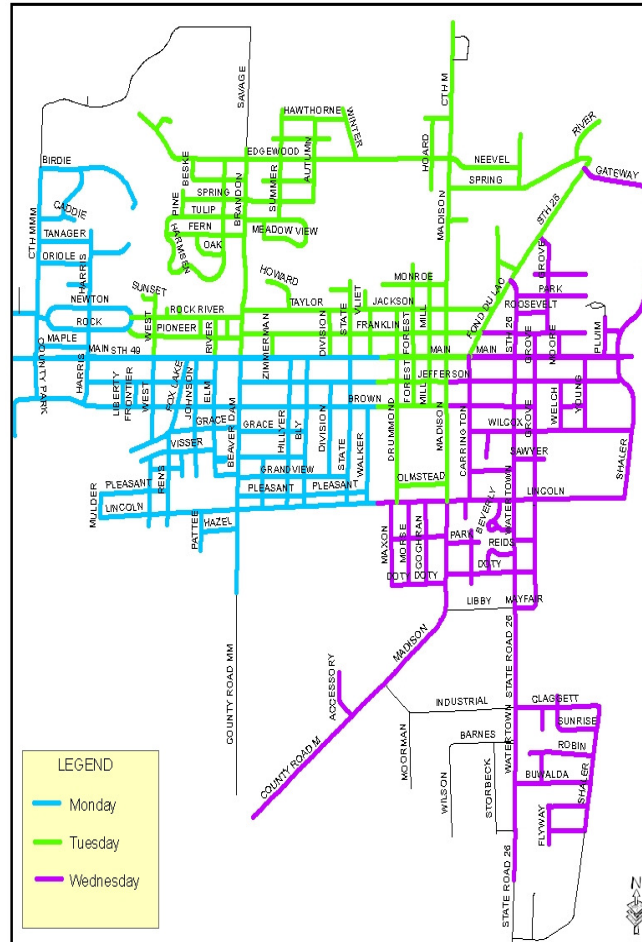
Cart Placement Guidelines

Advanced Disposal Automated Cart Collection program is designed to make it easier for residents to handle their waste & recycling services. With automated collection programs, there are a few cart placement guidelines to follow. Your help is appreciated in making it easier for carts to be collected:

- Your cart should be within 18 inches of the curb with the arrow on the lid pointing to the street/curb. Carts can be placed on the street or the terrace (as long as they are within 18 inches of the curb).
- To avoid damage to property, place the cart at least three feet from mailboxes, lamp posts, and other fixed objects.
- Place your cart on as level of a surface as possible, but away from low-hanging tree branches.
- Place recycling carts at least three feet away from garbage carts.
- Close lids prior to pick-up—lids should be closed on carts in order to stop material from spilling or blowing away prior to collection.

Commonly Asked Questions

WHO WILL BE PROVIDING SERVICE? The City has a signed contract with Advanced Disposal to provide residential curbside trash and recycling services.

WHAT WILL I BE CHARGED EVERY MONTH?

The charge for the weekly trash pick-up and every other week recycling pick-up will be \$12.91 per month. Each year there is a maximum adjustment rate of 2 1/2%.

WHO PROVIDES RECYCLING/TRASH

RECEPTACLES? Advanced Disposal will provide one 95 gallon yellow covered wheeled cart for recycling and one 95 gallon wheeled cart for garbage to every customer that currently pays for recycling services on your Utility bill.

WHAT IF MY CONTAINER IS DAMAGED? If your cart is damaged, please contact Advanced Disposal at (920) 387-0987 to schedule a repair or replacement

IF I MOVE TO A NEW HOME WHAT DO I DO WITH THE RECEPTACLES AT MY HOUSE? All containers are owned by and property of Advanced Disposal. The receptacles must remain with the property.

WHEN WILL MY TRASH/RECYCLING BE PICKED UP? Please see the map on the reverse side with the routes. Advanced Disposal will also be providing each property with a schedule. Information is also available on our website at www.cityofwaupun.org

All trash/recycling produced from a residence must be placed in the appropriate receptacle.

Electronics Recycling

Legacy Recycling will be providing Electronics Recycling to City of Waupun residents on **April 11 & 12, 2017** from 10:00 am—3:00 pm, at the City Garage located at 903 N. Madison St. The only fees that are charged is \$25.00 for good condition TV's, \$10.00 for Computer monitors, and \$40.00 for projection TV's, council TV's, DLP TV's, and broken TV's.

If an item plugs into an outlet or runs on batteries they can recycle it for you. More common items that can be recycled include:

Monitors (CRT, LCD, LED), Computers, Stereo Equipment, CD Players, All wires, Ipods, Copiers, Laptops, Rechargeable batteries, VCR's, DVD Players, Keyboards, Computer parts, Power tools, Scanners, Phones, TV's, Servers, Mice, Small appliances, Cable boxes, Printers, Cell Phones, Radios, Routers, Fax Machines, Microwaves, Game systems.

Bargains Galore Thrift Store offers electronics recycling. Items that can be recycled include TV's, CPU's, Laptops, Copiers, Phones, Mice, Keyboards, Computer Monitors, Printers/Scanners, Fax Machines, VCR/DVD players, Cell phones/PDA's, Stereo Equipment, Cables/Cords, Game Systems, Any & All Computer Accessories. Some fees do apply.

Bulk Pick-up

Part of the contract with Advanced Disposal is to provide residents with two bulk pick-up dates per year. The Spring pick-up will be April 10, 11, & 12, 2017, and the Fall pick-up will be October 9, 10, & 11, 2017. Bulk items will be picked up on your normal trash pick-up date. Items may not be placed at the curb prior than 24 hours to your scheduled pick-up date. Below are guidelines for pick-up.

The following items are identified as bulk waste that will be collected:

- Furniture
- Rolled carpeting (4ft maximum length)
- Cabinets
- Countertops
- Mattresses/bed springs
- Non-metal doors
- Wood windows
- Wooden playground equipment

Excluded items:

- Uncontainerized or piles of construction material
- Large appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, etc)
- Freon-containing items (refrigerators, AC units, freezers)
- Tires
- Batteries
- Fluorescent lights/bulbs
- TVs/DVD players/VCR
- Computer equipment
- Electronic Items banned from landfills

Advanced Disposal will be providing 3—30 yard containers for **wood related items only** (such as construction lumber, loose lumber) during the bulk pick-up as well. The dumpsters will be located at the Department of Public Works Garage, at 903 N. Madison St. The days and hours of operation will be Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday from 8am—4 pm during the bulk pickup days only. Residents will be required to show proof of residency. Materials other than wood related items, will not be accepted and will be turned away.

During the year, try to fit all trash material in the trash cart and all recycle material in the recycle cart if at all possible.
