Tuesday, April 19th:

Mayor Jodi Steger and the Waupun Common Council will meet in special session Tuesday, April 19th at 5:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers, City Hall. This is the annual organizational meeting following the recent April election for local

Aldermanic District elected members. Congratulations to Alderpersons Julie Nickel (District 1), Matt Hickmann (District 3), and Mike Johnson (District 5). Also at this meeting the following agenda items are acted on:

expense within each District the costs of projects that fall within ½ mile outside of the TIF District. Why is this important? This allows the City of Waupun to complete projects that benefit the community with the ability to pay for these projects without levying a property tax.

The Joint Review Board is comprised of representatives from all the taxing jurisdictions including the City of Waupun, Waupun School District, Moraine Park Technical College, and Dodge and Fond du Lac Counties. The Joint Review Board (JRB) will review the proposed amendments to the Tax Incremental Finance District plans. The JRB responsibility is to review the financial feasibility of the proposed amendments and adopt the project plans.
