JEFFERSON SCHOOL UPDATE

On Saturday, April 30th there was a walk through of the former Jefferson School building by approximately 35 persons representing a cross section of organizations in the City of Waupun. The purpose of the walk through was to gauge interest in the community for the use of the building as a community center. Some of the organizations in attendance were the Garden Club, Legion Baseball, Figure Skaters, Waupun Softball, Truck-n-Show, VFW, Senior Center, Lions Club, Historical Society, Waupun

Fine Arts, American Legion, Chamber of Commerce, Waupun Softball, Waupun School District, Common Council, and school and city staff.

Floor plans were provided to those in attendance as a guide. School staff conducted the tour highlighting the various amenities available such as computer labs, kitchen, gymnasium, storage, and media rooms. The groups met for a period of time after the tour to discuss opportunities for various activities and to identify groups interested in space. Some groups unable

to attend the walk through have since made contact and expressed interest.

We thank the Waupun Area School District for working collectively and providing access to the property.

It is important to note that this was an exploratory opportunity seeking out community interest in utilizing the building. There have been no commitments or approvals for obtaining the building and site from the School District. Much work is still ahead to determine the
