will be interning at City Hall and Waupun Utilities to do a project on energy. The project includes establishing a baseline for electricity, natural gas, and water usage by the City and Utilities and working with them to improve energy efficiency by decreasing use and implementing more efficient equipment where feasible. Alysa will also explore possibilities

for the implementation of renewable technologies. The project is part of the "25 by 25 effort" established when the Common Council passed a resolution that the City and Utilities would work towards obtaining 25% of their energy needs from renewable sources or by implementing energy efficiency measures by 2025. Some of the projects

that were recently completed in effort to meet this goal include efficient lighting upgrades at the DPW garage and utility administrative building garage, installation of energy efficient windows/door at City Hall, and installation of energy efficient blowers with variable frequency drives at the wastewater treatment facility.
