A Primary Election will be held Tuesday, July 12 to narrow the field of candidates for the August 9 Recall Election ballot. City Hall polling hours are 7:00am-8:00pm. Democratic candidates Jessica King and John

Buckstaff are the only two candidates listed on the ballot. Republican Senator Randy Hopper is running unopposed and will automatically advance to the August 9 ballot. July 8 will be the last day to register in the City

Clerk's office. After that date electors will need to register at the polls. The last day to request an absentee ballot by mail is July 7, and July 8 will be the last day to vote absentee in the Clerk's office.
