BASEBALL COMPLEX PROGRESS

Yesterday contractors began work on the detention pond, sanitary sewer, water, and storm sewer for the new baseball complex on E. Lincoln Street. The initial phase of the work involves a series of blasts (2 or 3 per day) which will continue for about a week.
