The band's featured vocalist Angela grew up and attended schools in Waupun before studying music at the College of St. Theresa in Winona, Minn. There she was able to develop her talent while also traveling to New York and the West Coast for singing engagements. She has sung with the MMJO as the band's featured vocalist since it's inception while teaching privately and playing with the instrumental jazz ensemble "Ladies Must Swing" and other music

groups in the Madison area.

Among the song's Angela will perform with the band on the Waupun stage are "All Or Nothing At All", "Someone to Watch Over Me" and "Got A Lot of Living to Do".

Casual dress fits the bill for the evening which begins at 6:30 when the doors open followed by "meet the band" at 7 then at 8 PM the music begins. The auditorium boasts a large wooden floor great for dancing with plenty of seats on the floor and balcony for relaxing and listening. A cash bar and refreshments will also

be available throughout the night.
