*AQUATIC FACILITY REFERENDUM*

During a strategic planning session held in 2010, Waupun Common Council identified 10 key goals to focus on. One of the goals is the development of a new aquatic facility or improvements to the existing facility at McCune Beach. A sub-committee was formed to research alternatives for the

facility, and 3 options were selected for further consideration. City residents will be given the opportunity to review the 3 options and vote for one in the form of an advisory referendum during the August 14<sup>th</sup> Party Preference Primary Election. City residents will soon receive a letter

containing information on the 3 options, including the anticipated tax impact, design concepts, and upcoming open meetings regarding the aquatics facility alternatives. Please watch your mail for more information or look over the design concepts following the newsletter.

*EXTENSION OF SHALER DR & MAYFAIR ST*

Last September work began on the extension of Shaler Drive and Mayfair Street on the city’s east side, near the Jr/Sr High. Just over

a week ago the asphalt was laid and the new streets were open for use. Later this year lighting will be installed and landscaping will

begin. The surface coat will also be applied at a future time.

*CITY-WIDE GARBAGE PICK-UP*

After several months of leg work and information gathering by Public Works staff, including many open meetings and a public hearing, the City is moving forward with city-wide garbage pickup. Veolia Environmental Services will hold the contract with the City for garbage

collection and a twice/year bulk waste pick-up. City residents will soon receive a brochure regarding these new services. The brochure contains information on when the service begins (in August), how you will be billed (on your utility bill), how to go about cancelling your current service, and much more.

As a result of the new bulk waste pick-up service, the Drop-Off Center located at 903 N. Madison Street will be closing, effective November 1<sup>st</sup>. On July 19<sup>th</sup>, the Fond du Lac Master Gardeners are sponsoring a bus trip that is open to the public. The tour includes stops at the Christopher Farm and Gardens in Sheboygan, West of the Lake Gardens in Manitowoc, and The Restoration Garden in Kohler.

West of the Lake Gardens is a 6-acre estate that includes a rose garden, Japanese garden, Sunken and Formal gardens. There are more than 900 feet of

herbaceous borders with colorful annuals.

Christopher Farm and Gardens have 50 acres of extraordinary gardens featuring over 35,000 perennials, rose, peony and lilac collections, grape arbors, vegetable and heirloom gardens, prairie, woodlands, orchards, vineyards, and beehives.

The Restoration Garden offers a wide variety of perennials, annuals, shrubs, trees and

heirloom vegetables. Beautiful giftware, garden art, statuary and pottery can be found in the gift shop.

# CITY OF WAUPUN, PROPOSED FACILITY AT THE FOND DU LAC COUNTY PARK




