City Hall Happenings

GENERAL ELECTION

The Fall General Election will be held Tuesday, November 6. Polling hours are 7:00am-8:00pm at Waupun City Hall. Items on the City of Waupun ballot include President, US Senator, US

Representative District 6, State Senate District 18, State Assembly District 53, District Attorney, and County Offices. Absentee voting may be done at the Clerk's Office at

Waupun City Hall during normal business hours 7:30am-4:30pm, Monday through Friday. The last day to vote absentee is Friday, November 2 from 7:30am-5:00pm.

BIKE TRAIL PROGRESS

The new segment of the bike trail – from Meadowview Park to Edgewood Drive – is progressing quickly! Bonestroo staff began working on the project earlier this

month and to date culvert pipe and rough grading are in, an estimated 1,600 feet of boardwalk has been installed, and paving was scheduled for

completion today. An additional 1,000 feet of boardwalk is left to install and the project should be substantially complete by the end of November,




