4 AND 5 YEAR OLD KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

4-year old kindergarten (4K)

Students must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2013 and live within the Waupun Area School district.

5-year old Kindergarten for students not in 4K

Students must be 5

years old on or before September 1, 2013. Students currently attending 4K in the Waupun Area School district will be moved up to kindergarten and do not need to register.

New for the 2013-14 School Year


