### MORE APARTMENTS COMING TO WAUPUN

Dave Decker, owner of Decker Properties, announced Tuesday he's building two new 16-unit apartments in addition to the two 16-unit apartments now nearing completion. There are currently five apartments that are available for rent out of the 32 units that were built this past year.

Groundbreaking on the Mayfair Street apartments was in October of 2012, and about as quickly as the apartments were completed, they were rented. According to Project Manager Mary Rens, people who work in Madison,

Beaver Dam or Fond du Lac can sometimes save as much a \$500 a month on a comparable unit and with Highway 151 near, the commute makes it worth it. Most of the renters to the phase I apartments were new to Waupun and commuting to work. In addition to price and location, the apartments are also state-of-the-art, with such amenities as large walk-in closets, front loading washing machines which use less water and soap, walk-in showers and two-car garages made extra deep for storage.

The Phase II apartments will be built so they look the same as the existing ones so the whole complex will appear as one unit throughout. With phase I completed, Decker Properties now has 124 rental units in Waupun. Groundbreaking for phase II is set for mid-August. and drink ticket / raffle ticket). This is a new 9 Hole disc golf course – please come out and see us.


