

FOWL BOOK SALE


The Friends of the Waupun Library will be having its monthly book sale on Monday, October 14

Bulk Item Pick-up

The Fall bulk item pick-up with Advanced Disposal Services (formerly Veolia) will be held the week of October 7, 2013. Bulk items should be picked up on your normal trash pick-up date depending on the amount of items that are at the curb. Items may not be placed at the curb prior than 24 hours to your scheduled pick-up date. Below are guidelines for pick-up. Contact Advanced Disposal Services at 1-800-387-0949 with any questions.

The following items are identified as bulk waste that will be collected:

- Furniture
- Rolled carpeting (4ft maximum length)
- Cabinets
- Countertops
- Mattresses/bed springs
- Non-metal doors
- Wood windows
- Wooden playground equipment.

Excluded items:

- Uncontainerized or piles of construction material,
- Large appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, etc)
- Freon-containing items (refrigerators, AC units, freezers)
- Tires
- Batteries
- Fluorescent lights/bulbs
- TVs/DVD players/VCR
- Computer equipment
- Electronic Items banned from landfills.

Yard Waste Pickup

The City of Waupun Department of Public Works will begin the Fall yard waste pickup service on October 7, 2013 and will continue through November 15, 2013 (weather permitting). This service is for the disposal of leaves, grass, garden waste, and branches that are generated from routine yard maintenance.

Please note the following guidelines:

- Leaves and brush shall **not** be deposited on the street
- Leave grass clippings and leaves at the curbside loose. **Please Do Not Bag.**
- Separate leaf piles and brush piles.
- Branches shall not exceed 3 inches in diameter
- No tree stumps or tree root systems will be collected.
- **The service is not intended for tree removal or lot cleaning.**

The City will not collect any items not in compliance with the above guidelines. Thank you for your cooperation.






