City Hall Happenings

TORNADO AWARENESS

April 21-25 is Wisconsin's Tornado & Severe Weather Awareness Week. The Statewide Tornado Drill will be Thursday, April 24th, with a simulated "Tornado Watch" issued statewide at approximately 1:00p.m. and a simulated "Tornado Warning" at approximately 1:45p.m. If severe weather is present on this date, the drill will be held at approximately the same time on Friday,

April 25th. If severe weather persists through Friday, the drill will be cancelled.

Siren testing is done locally Monday-Friday around noon. Saturday, at approximately noon, a countywide siren test is conducted through Fond du Lac County dispatch center. There is no siren test on Sunday.

Attached is a tornado & severe weather information sheet with helpful

information on emergency plans, tornado watches, tornado warnings and more.

Residents and businesses are recommended to have a N.O.A.A. weather alert radio for safety purposes. If you are interested in purchasing a weather alert radio, please check with our local merchants, or contact the Emergency Government Office at 324-7910 for more information.

LIBRARY ACTIVITIES



TORNADO & SEVERE WEATHER INFORMATION

EMERGENCY PLAN:

1. ***HAVE A N.O.A.A. WEATHER ALERT RADIO.***
2. Create an emergency plan.
3. Know where your shelter area is.
4. Prepare a disaster supply kit.
5. Practice your plan.

TORNADO WATCH:

1. Sirens usually do not sound for a “WATCH”.
2. A “WATCH” means weather conditions are favorable for a tornado to form.
3. Listen to the radio, television, or a NOAA Weather Radio.
4. Cautiously observe the clouds and weather yourself.
5. Be prepared to go to your shelter area.
6. Check to make sure you have necessary supplies available.
7. Please don't call the police or fire department for information.

TORNADO WARNING:

1. Sirens will sound for a “WARNING”.
2. A “WARNING” means a tornado has been spotted in this area.
3. Listen to the radio, television, or NOAA Weather Radio.
4. Have a battery-operated radio and a flashlight.
5. Stay inside. Know where your family members are.
6. Go to your safe shelter area you picked out beforehand.
7. There is **NEVER** a siren blown for an all clear signal.

AFTER A TORNADO OR SEVERE WEATHER PASSES:


1. Listen to the radio for information and instructions.
2. Inspect your home for damage.
3. Watch out for fallen power lines and leaking gas.
4. Stay out of the damaged areas.

Registration for the 2014 Fall Boys and Girls Soccer Leagues will be held **Tuesday, March 11th & Monday, May 5th** at Sully's Sporting Goods from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. Registration forms will be available at registration, your child's school office or the library in Waupun and Fox Lake. You may also obtain a form at Waupun Soccer's Facebook page or www.waupunsoccer.com. If you are unable to attend one of the registration dates, please fill out the registration form and send it to **WAUPUN SOCCER ASSOCIATION P.O. BOX 269, WAUPUN, WI 53963** with a check or money order only.

FEES: \$25.00 - U6 4K & K
 \$45.00 - One Family Member
 \$75.00 - Two Family Members
 \$90.00 - Three or More Family Members and is the Max any Family will Pay.

There will be NO registration forms accepted after 5/5/14 except under special circumstances.

- **Uniforms:** New players or players who move into a new division will receive new shirts this year. Be sure to mark the correct size. If a uniform is lost, a charge will be assessed, at cost, for replacement.
- **Other Equipment:** Shin guards, soccer ball, water bottle, and shorts.
- **Season Dates:** The soccer season opens with games starting in August and will conclude with the season tournament.
- **Teams:** Teams are created using a "blind" draft system, assigning each player a number so that coaches do not know which player they will be getting during the draft process. For this reason, special request are not taken. Siblings of the same gender and in the same division will play on the same team. The draft will take place mid June.
- **Coaches:** If you volunteer as a coach, there will be a coaches meeting after the draft this year. You will receive you roster and any other information at this time. The date will be made available in the near future.
- **Grant Program:** Funding may be available. A separate application form is required to apply for a grant. See form for specifics regarding the grant program. Application forms will be available at the registration or email waupunsoccer@yahoo.com. Applicants must be willing to volunteer some time, to receive a grant.
- **Volunteers:** Are always needed and greatly appreciated within the organization. Please sign up on the registration sheet, email waupunsoccer@yahoo.com or contact Ron Werts at (920)342-5235 if you would be willing to volunteer.
- **Winter Indoor League:** We are looking at an indoor soccer league to take place after Fall soccer ends. We will be taking a poll on the Registration form. If you are interested in having a Waupun Indoor Soccer League circle the Yes on the form. More information will be available at a later date.
- **Association Meetings:** Meetings take place at 5:30pm on the 1st Tuesday of every month at the Waupun Public Library. Past minutes are published on the Waupun Soccer Association's Facebook page. Stop by the meetings to get involved.


