4 and 5 year old Kindergarten Registration

The Waupun Area School District is in the process of compiling the **4-year old** and **5-year old** kindergarten lists for the 2013-14 school year. To register for either program please contact Linda Meagher at the Education Service Center at (920) 324-9341, extension 2117.

4-year old kindergarten (4K)

Students must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2014 and live within the Waupun Area School district.

5-year old Kindergarten for students not in 4K

Students must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2014. Students currently attending 4K in the Waupun Area School district will be moved up to kindergarten and do not need to register.

Child Care

Y-Care Child care is being offered before and after school at Meadow View and possibly SAGES. **A minimum of 8 students is needed to offer Y-Care at SAGES.
