AUGUST 12 PARTISAN PRIMARY ELECTION

The August 12 Partisan Primary Election is an election for the nomination of a candidate to represent a political party in the November General Election. The Partisan Primary does not elect a candidate to an office. The

candidate with the highest number of votes becomes nominated and is placed on the November Ballot for election. A voter may cast a ballot in the primary of only one political party, and may not cross over party lines. Voters select a party and then cast a vote

for individual candidates. Items on the ballot include County candidates (including Sheriff) and Assembly, Congressional & Senate Districts.

In-Person absentee voting hours are 8am-4:30pm July 28-August 8 at the City Clerk's Office.

The Waupun Chapter of Wings Over Wisconsin and the Waupun Gun Club are sponsoring a hunter education class on Tuesdays and Thursdays for two consecutive weeks. A parent or guardian must accompany students on Monday, August 11th, for a short

registration (between 6:30 and 7:30pm) in the lower level of the Waupun Safety Building located at 16 East Main Street. Classes begin on Tuesday August 12th, from 6:30-8:30pm. The final class will be held on Saturday August 23th, from 8:00am until 12:00 noon.

This hunter safety course is strictly limited to the first 50 Waupun area registrants. The cost of the class is \$10.00. DNR certified instructors will conduct the course.

HISTORIC ITEMS ON DISPLAY AT THE LIBRARY

In conjunction with Waupun's 175th Anniversary

Celebration, historic quilts and clothing are currently on

display in the upper level of Waupun Public Library.



(Pictured at left) A historic collection by Jayne Karbula includes a 1922 wedding quilt (at top) and an 85-year-old Mother-in-Law's quilt laying on a 1905 Steamer Trunk.



(Pictured at right) Above is a 75-yearold quilt made by Mabel Henning. Below is a baby quilt given to Ivan Koenig in 1933.



Joann Goodlaxson stands beside two of the oldest clothing garments on display at the Library. The original owner of the long black wool coat (at right) was her husband David Goodlaxson's great-great uncle, affectionately know as "Uncle Pete". He was a 2nd generation of Norwegians born in Waupun in 1855, when the city was only 16 years old. He became a painter by trade and his wife and only child died in childbirth. The 2nd oldest garment on display (at center)

is a beautiful two-piece white cotton dress. The original owner of this fashionable dress was a banker's wife in nearby Knowles, Wis. Both garments were worn in the late 1800's into the early 1900's. Many additional items from the extensive historic clothing collection of Mrs. Goodlaxson are also part of this special exhibit prepared especially for the City's 175th Anniversary.
