YMCA Pool Update:

- Alix provided update on attendance
- 2 lifesavers went up to the high dive boards to get kids
- 1 child passed out waiting in line
- Still working with City on chlorine levels
- Ran out of passes, new ones coming next week
- Campground directors came over angry over parking issues. Mayor Kyle dealt with it.
- Concession stand garbage a problem. Looking for signs that state "food not allowed on pool deck." Need signs to state "Eating allowed here."
- Angie may need to add Pool Park Rental and the Park Shelter form, \$75 for the rental
- Water aerobics will be Monday and Wednesday from 5-6pm for \$2 per person
- Shower temperature too hot for kids
- Ceiling windows in the concession stand leaks. Girls sink in bathroom is leaking.
- Paint sharp in the pool area, possibly chipping.
- Need cleaning supplies for showers and floors. Floors are extremely slippery.
- Signage for height restrictions on the slides.
- Concession stand fryer broken and Johnsonville machine fixed. A lot of food has been sold. Great crew working in stand.
- 10 guards scheduled on a day shift.
- Rick VantHoff on vacation 7/5-7/27/14
- Alix will manage Waupun Family Aquatic Center
- Angie will need to get them an answering machine
