Waupun Board of Public Works
Minutes of Regular Meeting - **Tuesday, April 8, 2014**
Approved May 13, 2014

The Waupun Board of Public Works met in regular session on Tuesday, April 8, 2014 in the City Hall Council Chambers with Chairman Bastian presiding.

Chairman Bastian called the meeting to order at 4:30pm.

Members present are Alderman Steve Bastian, Alderman Mike Johnson, Public Works Director Dick Flynn, Deputy Chief Loudon, and City Clerk Angie Hull. Alderman Pete Kaczmarek is absent and excused.

No audience is present.

Motion Loudon, second Johnson to approve the minutes of the March 11, 2014 meeting of the Board of Public Works. Motion carried 5-0.

No parking limitations on N. Watertown Street between Fond Du Lac Street and Park Street is listed on the agenda, but no discussion was heard.

An ordinance is provided to the Board for changing the speed limit on Beaver Dam Street. As you travel north coming into Waupun from Highway M, it's requested that the speed limit become 25mph sooner so the traffic is at a slower rate when approaching the school zone. Johnson states he does not believe this needs to affect traffic traveling south, going out of Waupun, only traffic coming in.

The current ordinance reads: A maximum speed limit of 25 mph shall apply to that portion of Beaver Dam St. (CTH "MM") extending from its intersection with Main St. southerly to its intersection with Hazel Court. A maximum speed limit of 45 mph shall apply to that portion of Beaver Dam St. (CTH "MM") extending from its intersection with Hazel Court southerly to its intersection with County Highway "M" (the business portion of STH 151).

The proposed ordinance reads: : A maximum speed limit of 25 mph shall apply to that portion of Beaver Dam St. (CTH "MM") extending from its intersection with Main St. southerly to a point 1300 ft south of its intersection with W. Lincoln St. A maximum speed limit of 45 mph shall apply to that portion of Beaver Dam St. (CTH "MM") extending from 1300 ft. south of its intersection with Lincoln St. southerly to its intersection with County Highway "M" (the business portion of STH 151).

Motion Flynn, second Louden to recommend to the Committee of the Whole to adopt the Ordinance to amend Chapter 6.02(7) entitled Traffic Code-Speed Limits. Motion carried 5-0.

Due to the new streets constructed: Mayfair Street, Taft Lane, Fraser Lane and Washington Avenue, the current ordinance is to be revised to provide where the stop signs are placed. Louden agrees to their placement. It's proposed to add the follow language to the current ordinance:

- (bj) Stop signs shall be placed at the intersection of Mayfair St. and Shaler Dr. so that traffic proceeding east on Mayfair St. shall stop before entering the intersection.
- (bk) Stop signs shall be placed at the intersection of Taft Ln. and Mayfair St. so that traffic proceeding north on Taft Ln. shall stop before entering the intersection.
- (bl) Stop signs shall be placed at the intersection of Fraser Ln. and Mayfair St. so that traffic proceeding north on Fraser Ln. shall stop before entering the intersection.
- (bm) Stop signs shall be placed at the intersection of Washington Ave. and E. Jefferson St. so that traffic proceeding north on Washington Ave. shall stop before entering the intersection.
- (bn) Stop signs shall be placed at the intersection on Washington Ave. and Wilcox St. so that traffic proceeding south on Washington Ave. shall stop before entering the intersection.

Motion Flynn, second Louden to recommend to the Committee of the Whole to adopt the Ordinance to amend Chapter 6.03(2) entitled Traffic Code-Other Intersection Controls. Motion carried 5-0.

Flynn provided the Acquisition Capability Statement for the Main Street project to the Board.

There are no public comments.

Flynn informs the Board that April 21-May 5, 2014 is designated as yard waste pick up, weather permitting.

Motion Johnson, second Louden to call the meeting adjourned at 4:40pm. Motion carried 5-0.
