WOUNDED WARRIOR VETERAN HUNTING BLIND

Members of Waupun American Legion Post 210 and Bentley-Hull V.F.W. Post 6709 stand by the new large NAPA handicap wheelchair accessible veteran's blind they donated 50% of the cost to for the Heroes' Hunt for Wounded Warrior Project in Waupun, which provides hunting opportunities for Wisconsin's injured and disabled veterans. Hunters will have a roof over their head and a heater to stay warm. A ramp leads to the blind which is located on the site of a retired Waupun landfill where numerous deer and turkeys roam the area. It's a way of thanking these men for their service to our country and helping to heal some of the mental wounds of combat.
