Waupun Committee of the Whole  
Minutes of Meeting  
Tuesday, January 27, 2015

The Waupun Committee of the Whole met in regular session Tuesday, January 27, 2015, at 5:30 P.M. in the City Hall Council Chambers with Mayor Kyle Clark presiding.

City Staff present are City Attorney Daniel VandeZande, City Clerk Angela Hull, Police Chief Dale Heeringa, Fire Chief BJ Demaa, and Utility Manager Randy Posthuma.

Audience present are Jen Kruel, Rachel Kaminski, Rick Vant Hoff, Hank Snyder, Wayne Verhage, Gary Chase, Sue Chase, Rich Smith, and Lori Smith.

Mayor Clark called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

Members present on roll call are Mayor Kyle Clark, Alderman Julie Nickel, Alderman Mike Johnson, Alderman Nancy Vanderkin, Alderman Ryan Mielke, Alderman Steve Bastian, and Alderman Pete Kaczmariski. No members are absent.

Jen Kruel, Chief Officer at the YMCA of Dodge County, introduced Rachel Kaminski who is the newly hired Program Director for the City of Waupun. Kaminski will oversee the Senior Center, Aquatic Pool Concessions, and the summer park program.

Fire Chief Demaa, Gary Chase, and Rich Smith appeared before the Committee. Chief Demaa made recognition of the two Firefighters as they both retired December 2014. Chase, who's years of service are 1979-2014, retired as a Captain and Smith, who's years of service are 1980-2014, retired as a Lieutenant.

Motion Nickel, second Vanderkin to authorize the City Clerk to make payment of expenses. Motion carried 6-0 on roll call.

Motion Johnson, second Bastian to approve the Operator Licenses of Sarah Sanders, Macalla Farr, Nicholas Landaal, John Budda, Bryce Day, and Sadie Smith; a Temporary Class B license to Agnesian Health Care Foundation for the Chocolate/Wine Festival on February 21 at the City Hall Auditorium and the Lions Club for Vegas Night on February 7 at St. Joseph's Parish Center; and a Soda License to Jimmy Johns as recommended by Police Chief Heeringa. Motion carried 6-0.
