

JOIN JUNIOR MASTER GARDENERS

Looking for an interactive, educational program for your child this summer? If you answered yes, then you'll want to check out UW-Extension's Junior Master Gardener (JMG) Program. It is a summer-long gardening/cooking program for youth, ages 8-12 years, that teaches them to "dig in the dirt", care for plants, cook in



the kitchen and eat healthy fruits and vegetables. Beyond gardening and cooking, your child will take field trips in the community, learn about insects and "dirt" from the experts, play fun games, and create lifelong friends (just to name a few.)

4K Registration:



The following items are identified as bulk waste that will be collected:



Excluded items:


- Uncontainerized or piles of construction material,


