TORNADO SAFETY

This week is Severe Weather Awareness week. Emergency Government Director B.J. DeMaa provides us with the following important information:

Emergency Plan:

- Have a N.O.A.A. Weather Alert Radio
- Create an emergency plan
- Know where your shelter area is
- Prepare a disaster supply kit
- Practice your plan

Tornado Watch:

- Sirens usually do not sound for a "WATCH"
- A "WATCH" means weather conditions are favorable for a tornado to form
- Listen to the radio, television, or a NOAA

Weather Radio

- Cautiously observe the clouds and weather yourself
- Be prepared to go to your shelter area
- Check to make sure you have necessary supplies available
- Please don't call the police or fire department for information

Tornado Warning:

- Sirens will sound for a "WARNING"
- A "WARNING" means a tornado has been spotted in

this area

- Listen to the radio, television, or NOAA Weather Radio
- Have a battery-operated radio and a flashlight
- Stay inside - Know where your family members are
- Go to your safe shelter area you picked out beforehand
- There is **NEVER** a siren blown for an all clear signal

After a Tornado or Severe Weather Passes:

- Listen to the radio for information and instructions
- Inspect your home for damage
- Watch out for fallen power lines and leaking gas
- Stay out of the damaged areas



ARBOR DAY

April 24th is Arbor Day. Each year people all across the nation take time to learn about and plant trees on this designated day.

How can you celebrate this holiday that is all about trees?

Residents on or in sight of the Rock River or its tributaries are invited to pick up **free Oak Trees** to plant on their property. Varieties include Swamp & Black Oak (which are better near

water) and White & Red Oak (which are better away from water).

Trees are great oxygen producers, some of the many other benefits of planting trees include preventing the shoreline from erosion, providing animal habitat, and reducing our carbon footprint.

Residents are encouraged to put protective wire or tubing around the trees to protect them from animals.

Trees may be picked up from the City Garage (903 N. Madison St.) on or after April 27th. Please call 324-7935 to check on availability.

For the younger crowd, a special **Family Storytime** devoted to trees will be held at the Library on Wednesday, April 22nd at 10:30am. We hope you can make it to this fun, educational event!




