### KOCK PIPELINE DONATES EMERGENCY RESPONSE EQUIPMENT

On August 5th, Koch Pipeline Company, L.P. (KPL) donated an 18-foot enclosed trailer stocked with emergency response equipment and materials to the Waupun Fire Department. The donation, valued at nearly \$30,000, includes boom, absorbers, a drum skimmer, pumps, compressors, generators, and related equipment that will improve firefighters' ability to respond to a hazardous materials (hazmat) incident.




