### CHRISTIAN HOME FUNDRAISING

The Christian Home and Rehabilitation, Inc. (C.H.), of Waupun would like to take this opportunity to share some exciting, and very important news with you. It is our hope that you care about the well being of the community's elderly and their families as we do.

The Board of Directors, along with the C.H. Administration,

has spent the past years looking toward what the future holds for our facility. After much research and discussion we have come to the conclusion that in order for the C.H. to stay viable and competitive in the health care field, we must replace our existing facility. If you are unaware of our situation, please let us give you a brief overview of who we are and what our

vision and mission consists of.

First of all, our history began over 70 years ago, when a group of church men saw the need to build a facility that would benefit the elderly in the Waupun area. The C.H. is a Not-for-Profit organization. We are not owned by a business, group or corporation, but by 16 Waupun and surrounding area Churches. Our

**CHRISTIAN HOME FUNDRAISING (Continued)**

Board of Directors (BOD) consists of one church member from each supporting Church that volunteer in the governing decisions. After several years of financial struggles, the BOD at that time, approached Agnesian Healthcare to assist us with their expertise in the administration of the C.H. Since that change, we have seen a dramatic change in our bed census, the financial stability of our organization, as well as the solid support from the community.

Since those early beginnings, our needs have changed and the medical advances have exceed our facility's ability. Our building is 61 years old and most nursing care facilities are replaced after 25-30 years. Considering the age of the building and many needed repairs, issues of privacy and up-dates, it is our desire to build a new facility next to the Christian Homestead (our Memory Care Fa-

cility, on the south-west end of Waupun). Our long term goal (10 - 20 years) is to have our Assisted Living facility relocated on the same campus as well.

We have decided that for the C.H. to provide a high level of quality care to our residents, possibly one of your loved ones, we MUST act now and implement the vision of constructing a new skilled care facility.

It is our intention to raise \$3,000,000 for a \$13,000,000 project. This projected budget includes; acquisition of 10.5 acres of land, construct a 50-bed skilled care modernized facility, state of the art rehabilitation area for in patient and out patients, provide the potential for Hospice Care, and support the needed repairs to our existing facilities. It is our goal to break ground in 2016, but we need Waupun Area residents and the surrounding communities to help us keep a nursing care facility

in Waupun. The big question is... Will you be willing to partner with us? It is our hope and prayer that many of you will join us in giving back to our elderly, by providing them with a comfortable place to call "HOME" when they are no longer able to live independently.

Along with this letter you will find our Mission Statement, Vision Statement, a brief history timeline that the BOD has taken over the past 70+ years, target dates, along with a brochure that we are able to have available to our supporters and potential donors.



### STEAM ENGINE TRAIN

Soo Line Locomotive 1003, one of the nation's last few operating steam locomotives, made a run from the Wisconsin Automotive Museum in Hartford through Waupun and Brandon on Saturday, October 31. It was parked in Fairwater overnight and returned to Hartford through Waupun on Sunday, Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>. Engine 1003 was originally retained as standby after 1955 when most of the steam locomotives were sold. It was officially retired in 1959, but restored in the mid 1990's and has operated successfully in numerous events of the years since.
