WAUPUN LION'S CLUB TO HOST LAS VEGAS FUN NIGHT

The Waupun Lions Club will hosts its annual LAS VEGAS FUN NIGHT on Saturday, February 13th at St. Joseph's Parish Center, 26 North Division Street, Waupun.

The games begin at 6:30 PM. Admission is \$15 per person, or \$25 per couple. 



WASD Facility Advisory Committee Tours Meadow View Primary School, Learns about School Finance

Waupun, WI - The Waupun Area School District Facilities Advisory Committee (FAC) had their fifth meeting on Tuesday, January 12, 2016. The committee continued their work in evaluating district facilities by meeting and touring the Meadow View Primary School. The meeting focused on learning about the school's curriculum and programs for approximately 240 Waupun area students in 4K, kindergarten and first grade. Committee members explored the school and learned about the strengths and limitations of the building from Principal Andy Kohn and other staff.

The current Meadow View Primary building has played an interesting role in the history of the Waupun Area School District. Originally constructed in 1957 as Jefferson School, additions and renovations to the building were completed in 1963, 1986 and 1998. Jefferson School served as a traditional elementary school in the District for grades kindergarten through fifth grade until 2009. In 2013, the building reopened as Meadow View Primary, specifically serving students throughout the Waupun Area School District in 4K through first grade.

Now close to 50 years old, the recent Facility Study at Meadow View noted a variety of facilities needs naturally related to aging building systems and years of use. The boiler, air handling equipment, original single pane windows and the water heater are outdated and inefficient. Electrical, fire alarm, and plumbing system components need significant upgrades and/or replacements. The building exterior requires tuck-pointing and rust removal between windows, and many areas of the school's floor are still covered in vinyl asbestos tile (VAT). A second area of weakness is the building's original design and configuration. For example, the present configuration forces grades to be isolated from one another and the cafeteria separated from the kitchen, which creates inefficiencies for staff and students. Another limitation is the lack of appropriate spaces for small student and staff groups to utilize; collaboration and group work for students is further hindered by the lack of flexible furniture. Additionally, the study identified a need for an improved and secure entrance sequence and controlled visitor access at the front of the school. It also noted the congested traffic flow during drop-off and pick-up times, which poses site safety concern for students. Finally, full compliance with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) codes is also a factor, specifically regarding door hardware and special needs toileting.

At the Tuesday night meeting, the FAC also learned about Wisconsin school finance and how facilities referenda are funded from Mike Clark, the district's financial consultant from Robert W. Baird & Co. Registered voters in the school district must authorize the district to borrow funds (typically tax exempt general obligation bonds) for facility improvements paid for outside of the revenue limits by approving a referendum. The Waupun Area School District last passed a referendum to borrow funds (or issue debt) when the current Junior/Senior High School was constructed in 1998. Because school districts in Wisconsin cannot borrow and repay loans for more than 20 years, the High School construction debt is now close to retiring, as they near the final payments for the 1998 referendum project. Clark explained that this creates a "window of opportunity" for the school district and

community to potentially address other facilities needs while maintaining a relatively stable referendum debt tax rate levy or minimizing a potential impact to taxpayers on any future referendum projects.

Now that the Facilities Advisory Committee has toured and met with staff from each school, the group will focus their work in the coming months on confirming priorities and reviewing preliminary options (with cost estimates) to address identified facilities needs district-wide. The FAC's preliminary recommendations will be shared with the entire Waupun Area School District later this spring in a community-wide survey specifically intended to gather additional community input. This feedback will help guide the FAC's final recommendations to the School Board, who will ultimately make the decision on what to present to voters for a potential facilities referendum on November 8, 2016. 
