## Waupun Common Council Minutes of Special Meeting Tuesday, April 19, 2016

The Waupun Common Council met in special session on Tuesday, April 19, 2016 at 6:00pm in the Common Council Chambers of the Waupun City Hall with Mayor Kyle Clark presiding.

City Staff present are Attorney VandeZande, City Clerk Hull, Fire Chief DeMaa, Economic Development Planner Schlieve, Police Chief Heeringa, Public Works Director Flynn, Utility Manager Posthuma, and Assistant to the Library Director Garcia.

Audience present is Vanessa Bastian.

Mayor Clark called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Members present on roll call are Alderman Johnson, Alderman Vanderkin, Alderman Mielke, Alderman Bastian, Alderman Kaczmariski, and Alderman Nickel. No members are absent.

Brian Ball of Wounded Warriors made request for hunting privileges at a prior meeting and was granted approval for hunting on "City property". During Ball's appearance, he made comment to the use of the City Landfill property and possible use of the City owned property near the State Farm. As the motion was unclear as to what property the Council approved, it is being discussed for clarification. Several Council members state they believe the intent was for the City Landfill property only.

Motion Nickel, second Kaczmariski to authorize the Wounded Warrior hunt by the City Garage/Landfill and to continue to investigate the possibility of the 151 land. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion Vanderkin, second Bastian to authorize the City Clerk to make payment of the monthly expenses. Motion carried on roll call 6-0.

Motion Johnson, second Nickel to approve the Operator Licenses to Mackenzie Schuenemann and Randall Blohowiak and Temporary Class B Licenses to Waupun Fine Arts for Concerts in the Park- Dodge Park 518 S Madison Street, on July 7, 14, 21, and 28, 2016; and Waupun Fine Arts for Art & Craft Fair- Dodge Park 518 S Madison Street, on August 6, 2016. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion Nickel, second Kaczmariski to approve the Taxi Cab License and the Taxi Cab Driver License applications from Jay Graff for Classic Chauffeur LLC dba Classic Chauffeur contingent upon approval of inspections and other requirements by City ordinance and State Statutes are met.

Kaczmariski questions if this business could participate in the taxi grant the City has. Mayor Clark states he would not as the grant has already been awarded. Hull informs the Council that inspections and proof of insurance still remain to be received. Fire Chief Demaa states he and the building inspector did inspect the premises of his business location and was informed by the owner that he knew nothing of this matter. Mr. Graff is not in the audience to answer questions of concern. Mayor Clark suggests this be tabled for a future meeting of the Council and Mr. Graff is asked to be present.

Motion Nickel, second Kaczmariski to withdraw the motion to approve the Taxi Cab License and the Taxi Cab Driver License applications from Jay Graff for Classic Chauffeur LLC dba Classic Chauffeur contingent upon approval of inspections and other requirements by City ordinance and State Statutes are met. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion Nickel, second Bastian to table the license applications for Taxi Cab License and Taxi Cab Driver License from Jay Graff for Classic Chauffeur LLC dba Classic Chauffeur. Motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Clark recognizes Alderman Steve Bastian's years of service to the City of Waupun and dedication to his constituents of his District. Alderman Bastian held office from April 21, 2009 to April 19, 2016.

Motion Bastian, second Mielke duly carried the meeting adjourned at 6:25p.
