Waupun Common Council Minutes of Meeting Tuesday, March 12, 2013

The Waupun Common Council met on Tuesday, March 12, 2013 at 6:00 PM in the Council Chambers with Mayor Jodi Steger presiding.

Mayor Steger called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

The Pledge of Allegiance was heard, followed by a moment of silence.

Members present on roll call are Mayor Steger, Alderman Bastian, Alderman Johnson, Alderman Vanderkin, Alderman Nickel, Alderman Mielke, and Alderman Kaczmarek. No members are absent.

City Staff present are Administrator Clark, City Clerk Hull, Library Director Jaeger, Public Works Director Flynn, Fire Chief Berry, and Police Chief Heeringa.

Those in the audience are Lieutenant Jeremy Rasch, Patrol Officer Stephanie Larson, and Attorney Joseph Sciascia.

Motion Vanderkin, second Kaczmarek to approve the February 12, 2013 minutes from the regular Council meeting. Motion carried.

No public hearing.

Person's Wishing to Address the Council:

Attorney Joseph Sciascia, candidate for Dodge County Judge, appeared before the Council to introduce himself and provide personal, educational and professional background information on himself. Attorney Sciascia will appear on the April 2, 2013 Spring Election ballot.

Chief Heeringa and Lieutenant Rasch introduced Officer Stephanie Larson who was hired in October 2012. Officer Larson has completed the field training officer program and is scheduled on second shift with floating to other shifts if needed. The Council welcomes Officer Larson.

Public Works Director Flynn informs the Council that the Light Equipment Operator position has been filled with Brian Markus who will begin employment with the City on March 18th. The Mechanic position is expected to be filled in the near future.

Motion Vanderkin, second Johnson to approve the Consent Agenda. Motion carried.

The Waupun Area Chamber of Commerce submits a letter of recommendation for the 2013 Farmer's Market to be held again at the Tanner Park location. Discussion was heard of possibly relocating somewhere closer to the down town area. Alderman Vanderkin states that was reviewed however a facility with bathroom facilities and electricity is needed.

Motion Nickel, second Mielke to approve the location of the 2013 Farmer's Market to be at Tanner Park. Motion carried on roll call 6-0.

Public Works Director Flynn informed the Council that the Department of Transportation will be holding a public informational meeting at the Waupun Library on March 21, 2013 at 6:30pm for the upcoming reconstruction of Main Street, State Highway 49 from County Park Road to State Street, Waupun. A citizen made contact with their representative in requesting to move highway 68 to Verhage Road. The Department of Transportation will be reviewing this.

Motion Bastian, second Nickel to approve the bills of the month. Motion carried on roll call 6-0.

Motion Vanderkin, second Kaczmarski to approve the operator licenses to Claire Strahota and Tyler Stobb. Motion carried.

Motion Nickel second Vanderkin to call the meeting adjourned at 6:25pm. Motion carried.
