

RESOLUTION # 08-13-13-01

A RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY ALTERING PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN ALL OFF-STREET WAUPUN MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS

THIS RESOLUTION is made by the Common Council of the City of Waupun;

FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS:

Based on the recommendation of the Board of Public Works, the Common Council believes that it may be appropriate to provide extended parking within off-street municipal parking lots in the City of Waupun.

The Common Council desires to apply such extended parking on a temporary basis before enacting a permanent ordinance, in order to more properly evaluate the need for a permanent ordinance change in this respect.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the above findings and determinations of the Waupun Common Council,

IT IS RESOLVED that Section 6.05 of the Waupun Municipal Code entitled PARKING LIMITATIONS is temporarily suspended, and the following terms and restrictions are temporarily adopted in lieu of such ordinance provisions:

1. When signs are erected in any off-street municipal parking lot giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle in such lot for longer than twelve (12) hours in any day, excepting on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas when parking shall be unrestricted.

2. This resolution shall not alter the existing winter parking restrictions identified in Section 6.05(4) of the Waupun Municipal Code, and no person shall park any vehicle in any off-street municipal parking lot between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. of any day during


December, January, February and March, except for areas designated in the Waupun Municipal Code as "Overnight Off-Street Parking Areas."

3. This resolution shall automatically expire one (1) year from its adoption, unless within this time the Waupun Common Council permanently adopts these provisions by ordinance, or otherwise alters or revokes this resolution in whole or in part by adoption of a similar written resolution.

4. While this resolution remains in effect, violations shall be subject to forfeiture as specified for violations of Section 6.05 of the Waupun Municipal Code.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be in effect on its adoption by the Waupun Common Council.
