CITY OF WAUPUN COVID-19 UPDATE: MARCH 18, 2020, 3.45 pm

WAUPUN, Wis. March 18, 2020 – In response to the COVID-19 pandemic here are the latest updates from the City of Waupun.

Earlier today, Governor Evers requested federal financial assistance for Wisconsin businesses. More information can be found at https://lnks.gd/2/DH_VhM. The Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation also announced the creation of Small Business 20/20 (SB20/20) which will provide grants up to \$20,000 to businesses with 20 or fewer employees.

City Hall is closed except for early voting and/or voter registration. Voters are encouraged to vote absentee for the April 7th election.
